There was no June meeting. The **Minutes** of the May Northeast Oklahoma Studebaker Drivers Club meeting are below:

Northeast Oklahoma Studebaker Drivers Club
Minutes of May 19, 2013

The meeting was held at Le Bistro Sidewalk Cafe, at 2 PM, 5970 East 31st Street, Tulsa, 74135 (near 31st and Sheridan) on Sunday, May 19, 2013. The meeting was called to order by President, Bob Canada, at 2:00 p.m. Those attending the meeting were Larry Love, Jerry Finckler, John and Nancy Kimbrough, Danny Fetter, Richard Allen, Alex and Helen Wilson, Bob Whiten and Lou, Cecil and Pat Kindy, Bob Canada, Bobby Burton and Michelle Fourroux. A motion was made to approve the minutes of April 21, 2013, meeting.

Jerry Finckler, Treasurer, gave the Treasurer's Report. As of the May 19 meeting, the balance in the account is an "around this amount figure." \$5,038. The zone meet brought in \$2,320, and, after expenses, we made a total of \$1.42. We have the \$200 that came in from the March Tulsa International Auto Show. The current balance is around \$3,200 and after all expenses, the deposit might be around \$1,500. Thus, probably the balance will end up between \$4,500 and about \$5,000. Jerry noted the figures are an "about" figure at this point. Bob, Canada congratulated the club on winning second place for the \$200 that came in from the Tulsa International Auto Show.

The Treasurer's Report was approved by the membership.

OLD BUSINESS

Zone Meet

Larry Love, zone meet director of the 40th Annual Zone meet April 26, 27, and 28, indicated that the meet went smooth. He requested any information from the members as far as improvements.

A suggestion was made to have the meet registration information put in a computer data base to send out a Thank You letter to those participating. The data base would allow easy access for sending out a letter next year to invite the participants to the 2014 zone meet. Jerry Finckler has the information about the participants on a spreadsheet and the information could, perhaps, be used as a mail merge for Excel. Larry Love will play with the mail merge and the email list of those who attended to see if this can be done electronically.

There were rumors that some participants were not happy with the judging. There was specifically one phone call about the new judging. The public relations of the zone meet was briefly discussed as far as who the club is marketing to and how many first places should there be. Danny Fetter indicated that he received a first place under the 2012 judging form and received a second place this year. Someone suggested, perhaps, there should only be 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place for each category. Another suggestion was to have the cars from the same class park next to each other which might make it better for judging.

John Kimbrough stated that he felt that the judging was very fair this year and that the issue can be re-evaluated for 2014. John Kimbrough thanked all the judges.

Michelle Fourroux suggested that the food for the judges be set up in the hotel breakfast room before the general participants start the lunch process.

Richard Allen said that he would donate a 1951 four-door Studebaker 6 Champion to be auctioned off. The car starts and turns over. Perhaps need to get some publicity out about the '51 to be auctioned off.

The club voted to have the 2014 zone meet at the same hotel, the Hyatt Place Southern Hills Hotel, 7037 South Zurich Avenue (near 71st & Yale). Bob Canada will get the hotel reserved for the last weekend of April, 2014. The last Saturday is April 26.
